





1. The vertical end blocking, which is both glued and stapled. I used five staples.




Image Notes

1. View of the bottom of the crate.
2. Notice that the blocking does not go all the way into the corner. This is to allow the crates to be stacked. Hence the corner blocking that extends on the top side.
